



PARTICIPANTS NEEDED

FOR A STUDY INVESTIGATING RURAL NURSES AND COMMUNITY ATTACHMENT

PURPOSE

This study aims to understand how sense of community influences the retention of rural nurses in the western provinces over time. This study aims to explore the dynamic processes and meanings of community to inform rural nurse retention over the long-term.

WHAT TO EXPECT

If you wish to participate, you will be invited to complete an interview that will take place over video (Zoom or MS Teams) or in person if feasible. This interview will take approximately 45- 60 minutes and will be at a time that is convenient for you. During the interview, you will be asked questions about your work experience, your community, and your general satisfaction with your rural setting. You will also be asked to submit photographs of any places that are special to you from your community.



WHO DO WE NEED?

Must be a Registered Nurse, Nurse Practitioner, or Registered Psychiatric Nurse with at least 2 years of experience in a rural or remote practice setting.

Must be willing and able to engage in a 45–60-minute interview.

Must reside in the western provinces from Alberta, Manitoba, or Saskatchewan.
